In 1918, A.J. Zilker deeded the 35 acres surrounding Barton Springs to the City of Austin. In 1932, Zilker agreed to give an additional 330 acres and despite the economic depression of the 1930's the land was developed into Zilker Park.

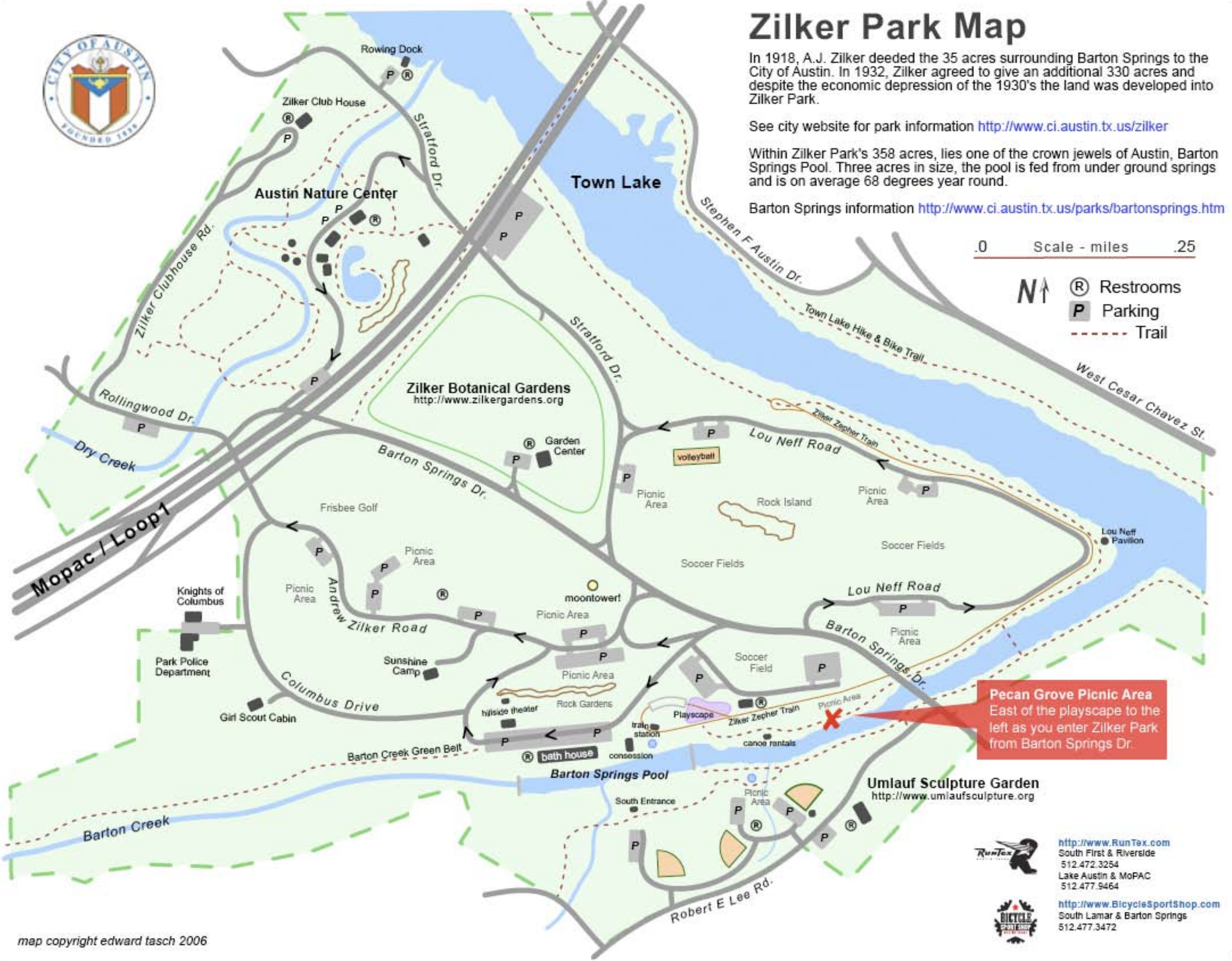
